

SUBJECT: Classification of Employees, Their Spouses and Children,
and Graduate Assistants for Purposes of Fees and Tuition

The Board of Regents at its meeting on June 24, 1977, adopted a policy on classification of employees, their spouses and children, and graduate assistants for purposes of fees and tuition. Their policy is transmitted herewith as a policy statement for Middle Tennessee State University. If any conflicts are identified between this policy and any other policy in effect now, or published in the future, the Board of Regents' policy will prevail.

POLICY: 5-01-04-10

SUBJECT: Classification of Employees, Their Spouses and Children, and Graduate Assistants for Purposes of Fees and Tuition

The following policies shall be applicable to all regular full-time employees, their spouses and children, and graduate assistants at institutions and area vocational-technical schools governed by the Tennessee Board of Regents for classification for purposes of fees and tuition:

1. All regular full-time employees, their spouses and children, shall be classified as in-state students for purposes of fees and tuition when enrolled in courses at any institution or school governed by the Board. See Policy 3:05:01:00 to determine status of spouses and children of individuals who are employed at Fort Campbell.
2. Graduate assistants shall be classified as in-state students for purposes of fees and tuition at the institutions where they are pursuing graduate studies as graduate assistants.
